

Conservation Practices for vendors on ELC Campus

The Environmental Learning Center encourages everyone to adopt sustainable lifestyles and business practices.

- Please conserve paper by printing on both sides of a sheet for any handouts. Please think before you print and avoid extra copies.
- Please take all materials with you when you leave- including trash and recycling. Please recycle all left over materials and compost when possible.
- Please refrain from single use plastics (including but not limited to plastic water bottles, googly eyes, straws, etc.).
- Styrofoam (polystyrene) is not allowed on the Environmental Learning Center Campus. In general, we suggest minimizing packaging, and using paper products in lieu of plastics.
 - We prohibit the use of Styrofoam (polystyrene) because it does not biodegrade. It persists in the environment and poses a threat to wildlife.
- Balloons are not permitted on the ELC Campus because most spaces at the Environmental Learning Center are open to the environment, or are accessed by outdoor walkways.
 - We prohibit the use of balloons because they do not easily biodegrade, persist in the environment and pose a threat to wildlife.
- Glitter is not permitted on the ELC Campus
 - O Glitter is considered a micro plastic that can easily pollute our environment and takes a long time to degrade.
- Products should not contain protected/illegal animals or their remains.
- The Environmental Learning Center is a non-smoking campus. Please refrain from smoking during your visit.
